### Introductions

• The meeting opened at 6:30 with introductions; 16 residents (2 on zoom), and 4 guests.

## **City Updates**

- Spokane Police Department Update (Officer Micah Prim)
  - o Crime hotspots along 29th Avenue and Grand Boulevard.
    - As the weather gets warmer, crime increases. Call in suspicious activity.
  - Shut garage doors at night and don't leave valuables in vehicles.
- <u>City Council Update</u> (Lili Navarette)
  - o Passed a resolution against cutting Medicaid for state and federal employees.
  - Cathcart proposed a good neighbor agreement for neighborhood councils.
  - Authorized \$350K for a contract with Evergreen Towing to remove abandoned vehicles and RV's.
  - o Concern was raised about increased street parking, leading to more car prowling.
- <u>City of Spokane Office of Neighborhood Services (ONS) Update</u> (Gabby Ryan)
  - o The new ONS Director, Heather Hamilton, will be starting in June.
  - Other ONS highlights:
    - Lilac City Live April 17<sup>th</sup> 2025 is the year of the neighborhoods.
      - 25<sup>th</sup> anniversary of NS and the NCs.
    - Numerica skate ribbon is now open for roller skating.

- Follow up on previous issues / concerns:
  - Planter Boxes near 19<sup>th</sup> and Grand
    - Our website claims that we planted plants here in the past.
  - Development at 1121 East 27<sup>th</sup> Avenue
    - Rockwood neighbors prepared comments on the permit application to subdivide this parcel into 4 smaller lots; the NC forwarded these to the city.
      - NCs are considered entities in the comment period.
