## Introductions

• The meeting opened at 6:30 with introductions; 15 residents (2 on zoom), and 4 guests.

# **City Updates**

- Spokane Police Department Update (Officer Micah Prim)
  - Rockwood is a relatively low crime neighborhood.
    - Cliff Cannon has currently had an uptake in crime.
  - o The current crime hotspot is around 19<sup>th</sup> and Grand Boulevard.
    - Most calls regard suspicious activity: Call Crime Check 509-456-2233.
  - Shut garage doors at night and don't leave valuables in vehicles.
- <u>City Council Update</u> (Paul Dillon)
  - Holding opioid meetings with Spokane County.
  - o The District 2 Town Hall is on June 9th at the MLK center.
    - Good Neighbor Agreement for homeless shelter facility siting.
  - o Working on an ordinance that would allow for block parties and special events.
  - o Perry Street sewer project is a challenge and will be completed by the end of May.
  - o Questions
  - O What about Prop 1?
    - We are working on a more comprehensive ordinance
      - The easy solution would be for the city council to simply prop 1.
    - Although 75 % voted in favor of it, he thinks it needs to be more carefully crafted.
  - O What about the new state rent controls?
    - He said there are some concerns about it, but he believes that it will help with more affordable housing.
  - o What is the timeline for the traffic calming project on Rockwood near 10th Ave?
    - The plan is scheduled for this Fall. He will get us the details.
  - O What about the new requirements to have a rental?
    - Yes, there is a business license requirement.
    - There is a city registry for awareness and to be able to assist with problems.
  - o Has the city looked at burying lines when major street construction like Perry?
    - Yes, the city will be burying the lines on Perry.
- <u>City of Spokane Office of Neighborhood Services (ONS) Update</u> (PollyAnne Birge)
  - The new ONS Director, Heather Hamlin, will be starting on June 2<sup>nd</sup>.



- Other ONS highlights:
  - The Spokane neighborhood Summit needs presenters
  - Saturday 13<sup>th</sup> from 9-1 is the battery take back for rechargeable batteries.

- Crosswalk at 29th Avenue and South Arthur Street (Traci Bemis)
  - Kids cross here on their way to the middle school.
    - There have been some near misses.
  - o **ACTION:** Bill will contact Comstock NC to develop a strategy.
