City Updates

- Spokane Police Department Update (Officer Micah Prim)
 - ***Spokane Police Department Public Dashboard***
 - Searchable database including reported offenses, traffic and collisions.
 - Two homeless people found near 10th and Rockwood were in possession of items taken from parked vehicles.
 - Keep track of your bicycle serial numbers to aid in recovery if stolen.
- City Council Update (Ginny Rammos)

 - CC Rules Update

 - A street racing ordinance is under discussion.

 - In order to have funds for food and beverages for the annual cleanup day on May 9th, we will need to vote on the CE grant application at the April meeting.
 - Discussion of the CE Grant included proposals for a movie night or purchasing Rockwood shwag to distribute.
 - Manito Methodist church is an option of an indoor movie night.
 - We are seeking volunteers to serve on the Events Committee to plan the 2026 neighborhood activities.
